### **March Township Manager Business:**

1. Dan Bell called on rental house – needs electrical inspection. Sent him to Jay Erb.

5. Attended day long FEMA/PEMA seminar at communications center in North Towanda.
6. Spoke with J. Jennings. She agreed to move abandoned vehicles. Building is scheduled to be repaired or torn down.
